This month we will be holding our annual Grandparents assemblies on the following dates:

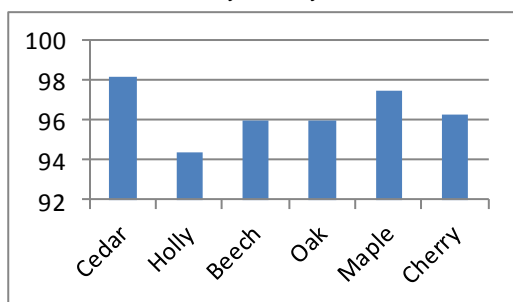
**28th March:** Holly, Oak and Cherry
