Firstly, thank you to everyone for your support in ensuring your children attend school, as regularly as possible. Our whole school attendance for the year to date is **97.4%**. You will find the class percentages detailed below.

I would like to remind you that the Department for Education expectation is that your child will have an attendance rate of at least **96%** so we are currently above this expectation for the whole school.

I do appreciate that illness and sometimes family circumstances are beyond your control and absence cannot be avoided however, it is my responsibility to inform you of the cumulative effect of those absences.

Finally I would like to remind all parents that leave will only be granted in exceptional circumstances and it is the policy of Surrey to issue penalty notices to all parents that remove their children from school for unauthorised holidays.
