Our daily timetable, at school always includes: Phonics, Reading, Writing, Maths and Independent learning. Please choose an activity from each subject to complete each day.

Phonics: We are currently working in **Phase 2**: (s/a/t/p/i/n/m/d/g/o/c/k/e/u/r/ tricky words- I/ no/ go/ into/ the) and **Phase 3**: (j/v/w/x/y/z/qu/ch/sh/th/ng/ai/ee/ai/oa/ou/igh/ear/ow/ar tricky words- he/she/we/me/be/was/my/you) Phonics Play is a very useful website: https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/freeIndex.htm (you don't need to subscribe©)

Reading: Please continue reading school books, library books, books from home. Also please use Reading Eggs (remember your child's log in is in the front of their reading record book) as there are lots of books and activities on there as well.

Writing: Any writing is good practice; use bookmarks in front of reading books for high frequency and tricky words, write words from reading books, draw a picture and write about it, use CVC (consonant vowel consonant words) e.g. cat and use them in a sentence

e.g: cat I can see the cat

hen The hen is in the shed

Maths: Count everyday objects, search for shapes around the house, identify colours, measure items around the house, practice number bonds to 10 and 20 and practice adding and taking away calculations.

Independent Learning: Independent learning is a great way for children to problem solve, be creative, make links in their learning and have fun. Some ideas include:

- Junk modelling
- Lego
- Colouring
- Playing with characters and figures
- Creating dens
