Try to include in your writing:

Similes Questions/ Exclamation marks

- -Keep a daily diary.

- -Practice spelling common exception words. Test yourself.
- Write a fact sheet about your favourite animal.

Maths

- -Practice your 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables in and out of order.
- -Practice adding 2 two digit numbers using either column method or sticks and crosses method.
- -Practice subtracting 2 two digit numbers.
- -Practice telling the time to half past, quarter to and quarter past. (or to the nearest 5 minutes if you can!)
- -Practice sharing and grouping numbers (multiplication and division.)
