
Remember the plan says we have to do a little bit at a time, so not everyone can go back as this would be too much.



When we come to school we might come in a different way






Our parent or carer will drop us at the correct entrance

We can still bring our own packed lunch




If we usually have a school dinner it will now be rolls or maybe sandwiches and it will be delivered in a bag

If we feel sad or worried we can talk to our adults at school and at home and they will help us feel happy and calm.


If we are poorly at school, staff will look after us as usual.
