

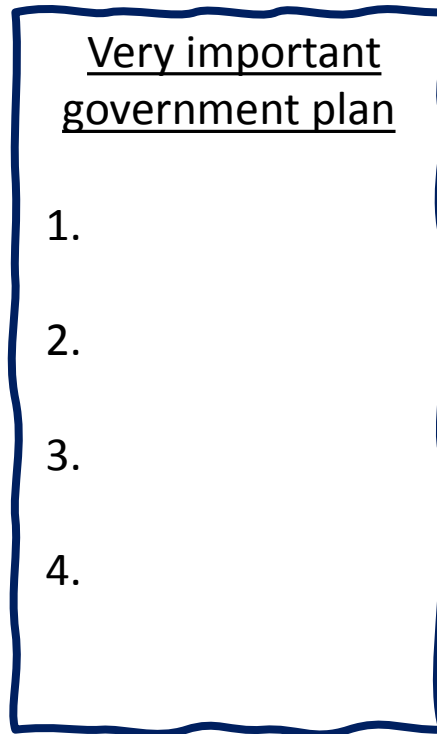


Our school has been closed

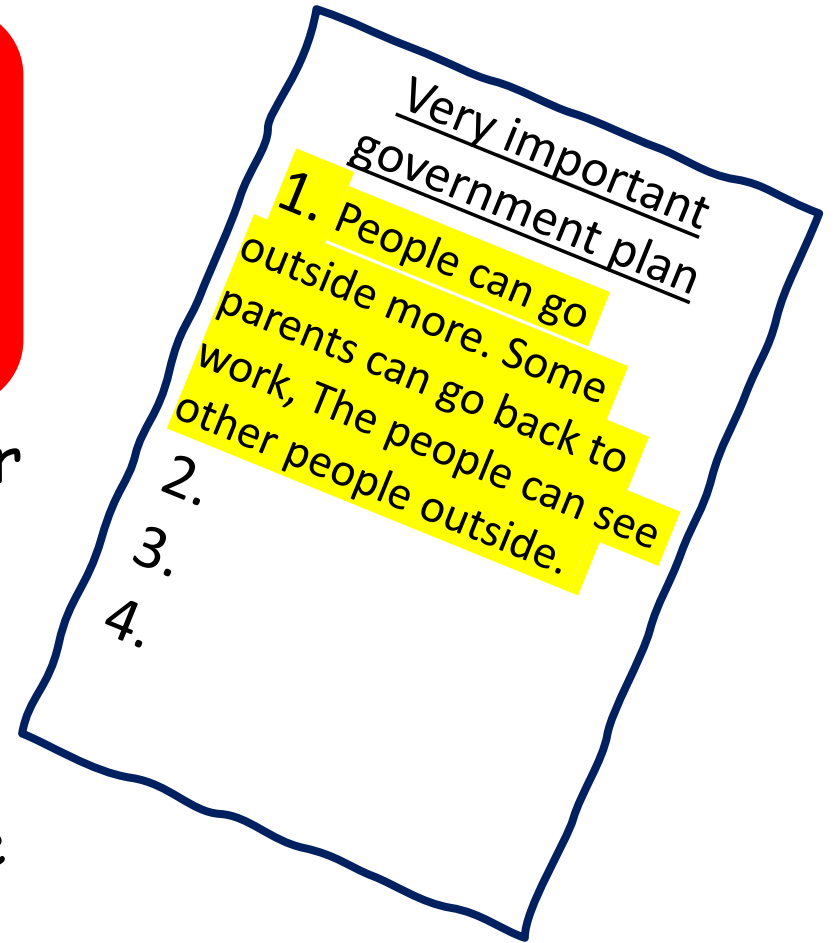
A plan is a list of things we ALL have to do to make sure we

You might be able to see other people from outside your house, but you still must stay 2 metres apart

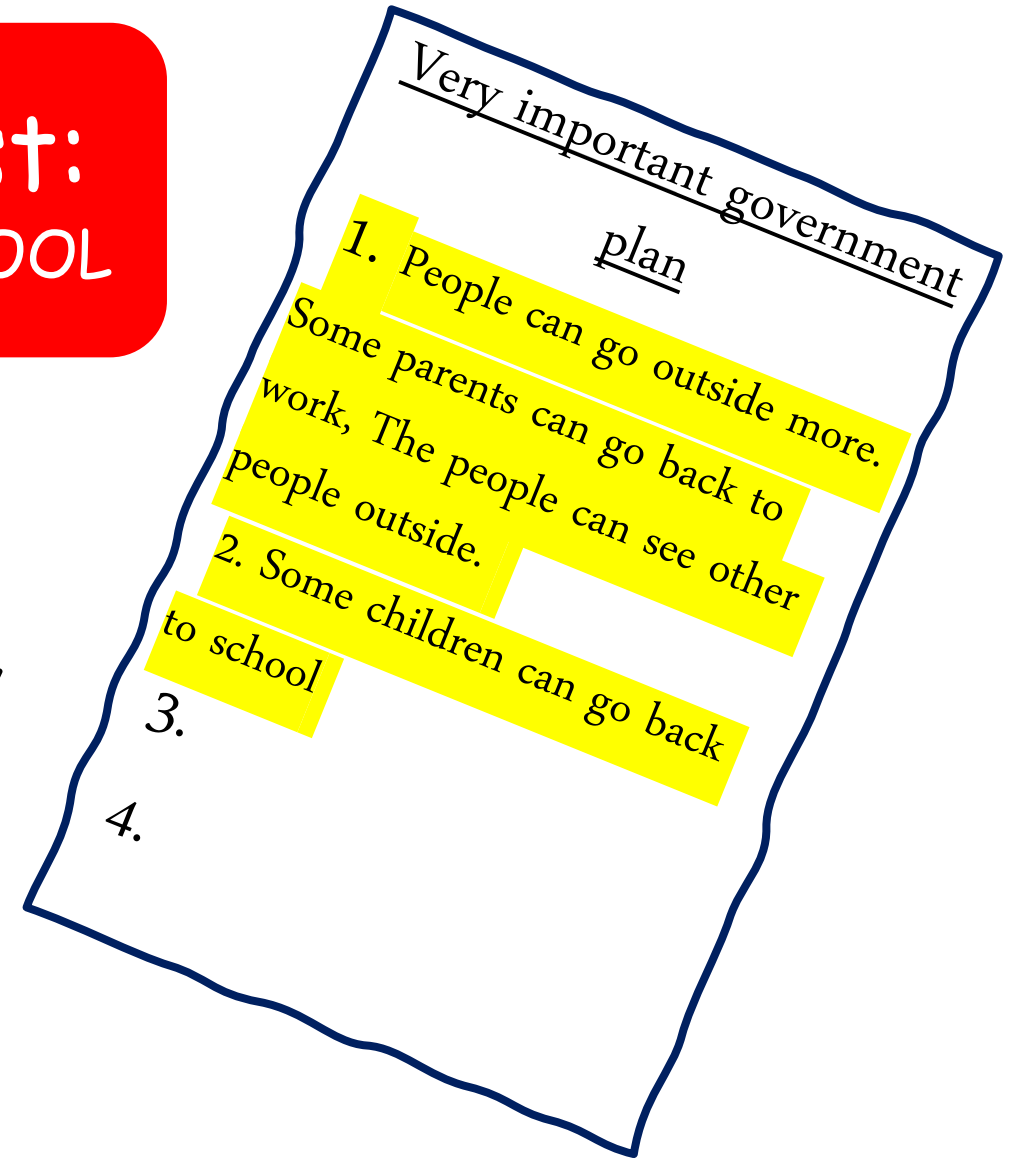
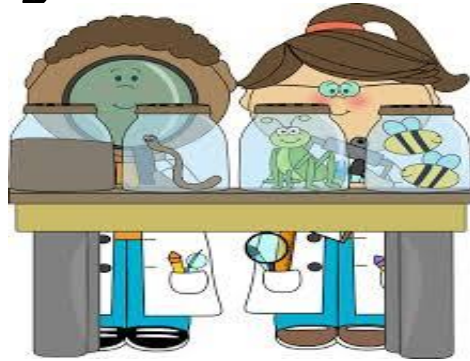


It is very important that we now stick to the plan

Remember the plan says we have to do a little bit at a time, so not everyone can go back as this would be too much.



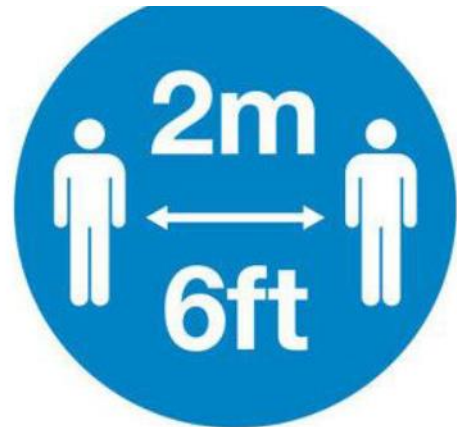
We will have some new rules to help keep us happy, healthy and safe.

correct entrance



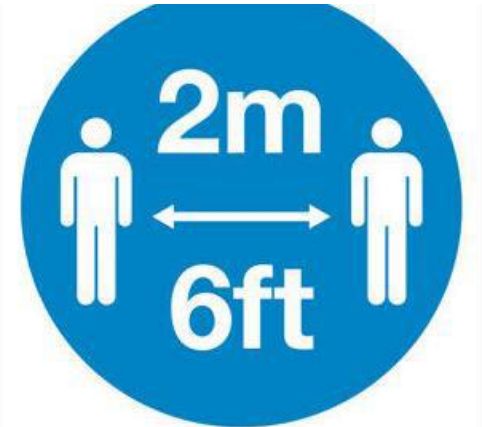
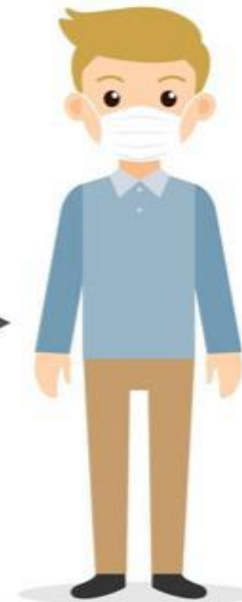
We will be staying in smaller groups than usual when we work and when we play. We will try and stay 2 metres apart. This will keep us safe.

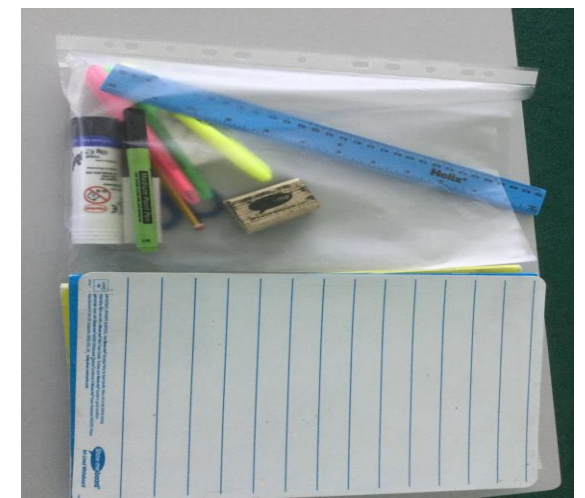


We will have to stay in our same group with our same adults all the time

We will still be with some friends from our class and staff that we know

We will not be able to touch or hug our friends and we won't be asked to share.

We might be in a different classroom and it will look a little different



In year 1 and 2 we will have our own table and chair where only we can sit and in Reception we will have our own mats.

We will have our own pack of everything we will need to help with our learning

We will keep our water bottles, lunch boxes and coats in our classroom. We do NOT need our book bag or PE kit

Only one or two people will be able to go the toilet at a time.

We must wash our hands afterwards.

We will need to wash our hands and use hand gel regularly to keep us healthy and safe.

We can talk and laugh with our friends and adults but we will try not to touch them and to keep a safe distance between us.



If we feel sad or worried we can talk to our adults at school and at home and they will help us feel happy and calm.

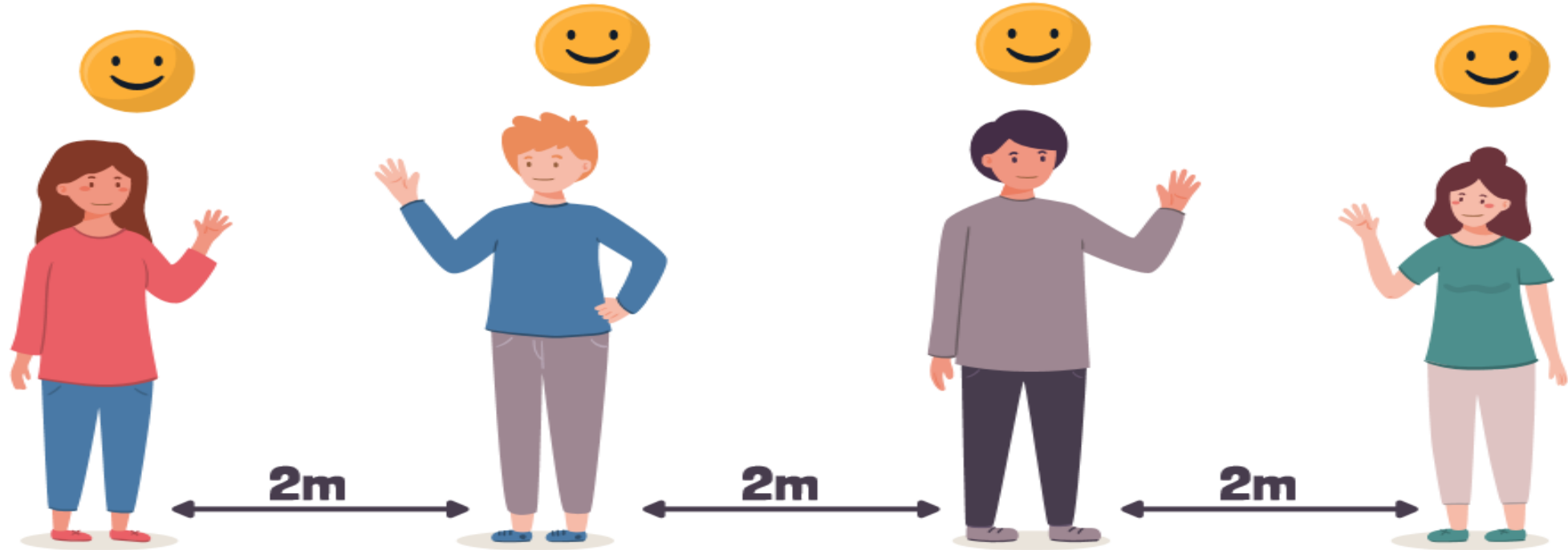
If we are poorly at school, staff will look after us as usual.
