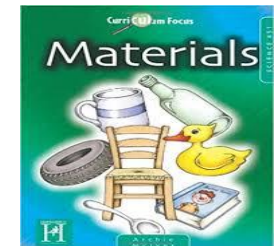

Raincoat .....?

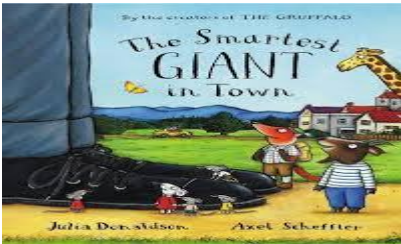

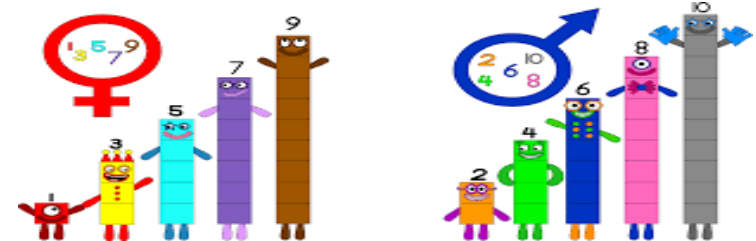
