This week we are learning

English	This week in English we are looking at the story Dogger by Shirley Hughes. Each day we will be working on creating our own story using
	a story board. The idea is that children build on this to have a go at creating their own story about a lost toy, even if it is through just
	using drawings.
Maths	This week we are continuing to work on our Place Value with numbers up to 10. We will be comparing numbers, ordering objects, looking
	at and using a number line and using ordinal numbers.
Phonics	This week in phonics we are working in phase 3. We will be recapping the sounds y, z, zz and qu. The children will be practising to read
	these sounds and write them in words and sentences. We will also be saying the alphabet everyday to help us remember the letter
	names. When writing we encourage the children to use the letter names when spelling something out opposed to the letter sounds.
Handwriting	We are practising our handwriting every day now in our handwriting books.
PE	This half term we will be working on our balance and coordination. The children have to stand and practise standing still in a range of
	different movements, we are also working on moving around either on one leg, something on our heads or holding something to ensure
	we stay balanced.
