Dear Parents and Carers,

We have come to the end of another busy week in school, and we are certainly feeling the chill in the air in the mornings now! In the meantime, can I please ask that you log in to your child's Google Classroom account and check everything is working, from your end, and start to submit normal homework this way. Google Classroom is the platform we will use to send your child work, should a class have to close. I would like to thank Holly class parents and carers who stepped up to the home learning challenge brilliantly on Tuesday and supported their children so well.

# Drop off and Pick up

It is extremely important that your children remain with you when queuing and waiting to come into school in the mornings and whilst waiting for siblings in the afternoon. I am seeing increasing numbers of children playing and running around the carparks, across the front of the school and out on the pavement. Not only is this a risk in terms of COVID it is a very real risk to their safety. The road is narrow and cars do not always drive at appropriate speeds. Whilst we endeavour to organise contractor visits outside of drop off times this is not always possible and contractors may drive into the carparks. Wherever possible I would encourage you to hold your child's hand and in the very least ensure they remain with you at all times.
