This week we will be covering the following:

Maths: Money Week 2

- Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p); combine amounts to make a particular value.
- Find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.
- Solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change.

Science: Animals including humans

To identify and label different teeth correctly.

To describe the function of each type of tooth when eating.

To know how to look after teeth.

Spelling

Short oo sound (book, cook)

-le word endings (bubble, trouble)

English: Non-fiction/information texts

Week one of a two-week sequence of lessons based on the books: 'Dogs' and 'Matilda's Cats' by Emily Gravett.

Spoken language: to participate actively in collaborative conversations; ask relevant questions to extend understanding and knowledge; Participate in a discussion; articulate thoughts audibly and fluently in Standard English

Reading: to identify and discuss the way texts are organised in a wider variety of genre (e.g. headings, chapters, or different non-fiction text formats)

Writing: to write expanded noun phrases to describe and specify

Art: Colour mixing – tints and shades
