This week we will be covering the following:

Maths: Money

- Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p); combine amounts to make a particular value.
- Find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money.
- Solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change.

English:

Week Two of a series of lessons based on 'The Cat that Scratched,' by Korky Paul

Plan by saying aloud before writing; develop narrative features including opening, middle and ending, and writing events in a chronological order; use adjectives, adverbs and expanded noun phrases to describe; use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences.

The children will be learning the story before rewriting it and then planning a new story based on this one.

Science: Animals including humans

Carry out a planned investigation to find out: who runs the fastest in Year 2 – girls or boys? (weather permitting)

Or

The importance of good hygiene for humans. We will be carrying out an investigation to find out the best way of washing hands to prevent the spread of germs.

Topic:

R.E.: Remembrance Day

History: Guy Fawkes – Who was he? What did he do? Why in Bonfire Night held each year?

Art: Making Remembrance poppies

P.E. Multi skills – To learn about a static base and losing balance.
