Our children have created wonderful portraits of the Queen for the exhibition and it would be fantastic if you and your child were able to visit. The exhibition is free and not only showcases our children's work but also that of Connaught Junior School.

St Anne's have asked me to share further details of a special event they are holding on Saturday 4th June:

As you are probably aware, your child has done a portrait of The Queen at school, which will be displayed at St Anne's Church (45, Church Road, GU19 5EQ) as part of the Jubilee exhibition. As well as the portraits, there will be a photographic exhibition of Bagshot over the ages, artwork from Connaught Junior School and flower arrangements. There will be a craft activity available for children.

There will be tea, coffee and cake available, but we additionally have got a licenser to sell alcohol for the afternoon of Saturday 4th June. We have a hidden garden out the back of the church, which overlooks Bagshot Park - first built for the Prince Albert, Duke of Connaught (Queen Victoria's third son) and now home to Prince Edward, Earl of Wessex (The Queen's third son). Very fitting for the Jubilee!

So why not take the opportunity to join us on your way to or from the Big Bash on the High Street, between 1pm and 5pm to see your child's portrait on display in the Church - and have a glass of wine or a beer (and eat cake, what's not to like?!).
