Meet the Teacher

We will be holding our 'Meet the teacher' meetings, in person this year. Parents and Carers are invited to come into school, at 2.45pm for a short talk from your child's class teacher. At the meeting, teachers will share with you, general information about the plan for the year ahead, class routines, expectations around home learning etc. For those of you unable to attend, a handout will be sent home, detailing all the information shared. Please take note of the date for you child's year group.

Parent/Teacher consultation evenings, when you will have an opportunity to discuss your child's progress individually this term, are also listed. These will also be held in person this year. Closer to the time, we will send you further information on how to book an appointment.

Finally, we operate an *open-door* policy here at Bagshot Infant School, meaning, if you have a question please come and ask us! You will usually find me on one the gates in the morning, and at the bottom ramp gate, at the end of the day. The mornings are always a little busy for teachers so if you have a question for teachers, please do speak to them at pick up time.

School Lunch

Just a reminder that every Infant school child is entitled to a free school lunch. Our caterers, *Twelve 15* are able to cater to most dietary needs and I would encourage everyone, to encourage their children to try school lunch, if they haven't already. If your child has not previously eaten school lunch, or would like to try again, please email the school office to let us know they would like to change. We ask that you do not switch between school lunch and packed lunch once that decision has been made. This enables our cook to order enough food and supplies.
