I would like to ask for your help with improving safety outside of our school. I am mindful, that whilst it is much colder, more families are travelling by car and at peak times, our narrow lane and footpaths can become incredibly congested, with both vehicles and pedestrians. Thankfully, we have not had an accident, but there have been several near misses recently and I therefore ask, when you are driving along the lane, please do so slowly, and vigilantly, always park and walk your children to the gate at drop off and when you do park, please park safely, turning your engines off when stationary, and respectfully of both fellow parents, and our neighbours. The pavement, adjacent to the school gets very busy, to ease this, please cross over to the other side once you have dropped off or collected your child. This is a simple way to help ease some of the pedestrian congestion.
