#### **Book Swap**

We will then hold a book swap, allowing the children to choose a 'new' book to bring home. **Please bring books to school on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February**

#### **Storytime**

Staff from across the school will be sharing their favourite stories, from when they were a child, with the children, across the school each day.

#### **Dressing up**

The children, and staff, are invited to come to school dressed as their favourite character from any book on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**. It would be good to discuss with your child, different characters from their favourite books. The dressing up possibilities are endless: Postman Pat, Oliver Twist, Fantastic Mr Fox, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, James and the Giant Peach, Danny- Champion of the World, Matilda, Goldilocks, Jack and the Beanstalk, The Twits, Cinderella, Gruffalo, Elmer the Elephant, Three little Pigs, Harry Potter etc. Please also send your child to school with a copy of the book their character is from, so they can share it with their classmates.

We will also be holding a special whole school outdoor parade, on the day for the children, so that they can show each other their costumes.
