

Football Club Terms and Conditions

This document contains essential information about the **Football Club.** You will be asked to sign to confirm that you have read and understood this information. Please keep a copy to hand so that you can refer to it when necessary.

The Football Club

The *Football Club* is managed by Bagshot Infant School. It is open to children, aged 4 to 7, who are pupils of Bagshot Infant School. It operates after school from **3:10pm to 4:15pm** on a Wednesday afternoon.

The Football Club is located on the school field (Bagshot Infant School, School Lane, Bagshot, GU19 5BP.

You may contact the club directly (during operational hours only) on 01276 473385. In the unlikely event of the field being out of use for any reason, the school will endeavour to operate the *football club* in an alternative space within the school. If the school is closed, due for example to adverse weather, the club will not run and a message will be posted on the school website.

Booking Procedure

Sessions must be booked for the whole half term in advance, accompanied by payment in full, and places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The booking form will be issued in sufficient time for parents/carers to book the next half term set of sessions. We are unable to accept bookings without payment in full.

Bookings are not transferable.

Fees and Payments

The charge for the Football Club is £4.00 a session.

This charge applies to all sessions that have been booked and whether or not the child attends the club at the school for part of any session. A receipt will be issued, once all monies and booking form have been received. Fees will be reviewed regularly to ensure they cover the cost of operating the club and a half term's notice will be given for any changes.

Changes to bookings

We are not able to offer refunds for missed sessions due to illness, holidays, school trips or other absences, or where the pupil attends only part of a session.
