Parents of Autistic Children & Young People Group Health and Wellbeing Coaching

These two hour sessions are for parents and/or carers of autistic children and young people (0-25 years) registered to a Surrey Heath GP practice. These sessions will focus on your wellbeing as a parent/carer and any support you need. The sessions will cover:
