## **Forest School**

We are pleased to inform you that all year groups will continue to have *Forest school* sessions, though-out the year led by Mrs Whelligan, on the days she is not teaching Holly Class. With that in mind, we ask that every child brings a forest school change of clothes to school, to stay in school, on their peg, much like a pe bag. The clothes should not be new, an old pair of jogging bottoms, a pair of socks, a long sleeve top and an old rain mac are ideal, as the children will get dirty and muddy! All children will also need a pair of welly boots, to be left in school. Please send the clothes and welly boots into school in a named bag, ensuring all items are also named!
