2nd hand costume sale

This is run in a similar way to the cake sale, however rather than cakes we sell your generous donations of unwanted fancy dress. We typically hold one before the October half term holiday so that you have the chance to get rid of some old costumes and hopefully bag yourself a bargain buying a new one.

Silver Smarties

Just before February half term the children will be given a tube of smarties, allergy dependent or a dietary alternative. These are 100% for the children to eat!! We ask that the children do some jobs over the half term in exchange for some change to put in the empty tube. When the children return from half term they bring their earnings in and these get donated to the school.

Coin Race

Leading up to the coin race, we ask for you to keep hold of any loose change that might be lying around. On the race day we ask that the children bring in whatever they can manage. The six classes have a competition, laying out all their coins in a big long line to see firstly, who's got the longest line, and secondly which class has got the highest value line. The children love this event, as do the staff as it's a great way to sneak in some extra maths work!

Party night/school disco

This is a traditional school family disco held in the school hall with a DJ, music and dancing. We have stalls, where the children can spend some of their pocket money on sweets, glitter tattoos, pocket money toys etc. The party night ticket includes a drink and snack for the children. The event is not a drop off, it is for a parent to attend with their child. (Parents are not required to buy a ticket) There is a bar where parents can buy alcoholic drinks, soft drinks and snacks.

Quiz night

This is an adults' only event!! Most recently we have a team for each class and a staff team. If there are more people than can fit in a team it is possible to make an additional team. The quiz night is held in the school hall. There is a bar where you can buy alcoholic drinks and soft drinks, you bring your own snacks/food to this event.
